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Gabe,

Forgive me if I'm wrong, but the GZIP option in phpSpeedy turns it on for more than the `php_speedy/cache/js/_cmp_javascript_#` and `cache/css/_cmp_cssstylesheet_#` files.

Right now, Joomla GZIP is on. The template (YooTheme) is enabled to GZIP it's own CSS and JS, which is good. They are `css.php` and `js.php`, so they don't get caught by phpSpeedy.

If there was a switch to use phpSpeedy GZIP setting only for itself, not global, I'd be home free. Any value in that for the masses?

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Hi Chris,

You can have speedy `_not_ Gzip` the HTML page and only the JS and CSS files it detects (puts in the cache directory).

The option is in the speedy plugin parameters under "Gzip Compression Settings" labeled, "Gzip Page". Setting it to "no" should stop speedy from gzip'ing the page.

Is that what you wanted?
