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You can either user or {geshibot} tags. Using requires that you disable the WYSIWYG editor. (It is the wysiwyg editors that do the html entities conversion, not Joomla)  
Using {geshibot} allows you to use the editor.

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Joomla does strip out code (can be fixed by the whitelist / blacklist thing), but the WYSIWYG also strips and messes with code, the effects change with different editors.
